# GOALS

- To replace a 1996 Fire Engine located at Station # 2 with new similar apparatus as recommended by a committee.
- To reduce the Fire Department Fleet by selling one Fire Engine at Station # 1 and not replacing it.
- To put a substantial down-payment using funds previously set aside for replacement apparatus.
- To benefit from low interest rates to fund the remainder of the cost.
- To have a replacement Fire Engine that meets the current safety standards and requirements.

Engine #12 **1996** Pierce Lance Quint – Squirt  
**(26 years old)**

Will be replaced with a modern similar unit



Engine #5 **2005** Seagrave Marauder Quint – Meanstick  
**(17 years old)**

Apparatus reduction / Will be sold and not replaced

# EXPECTATIONS

## New Engine

- **Ladder** - aluminum or steel - 75 foot
- **Cross lays** – 3 preferred / 2 minimum
- **Rear lays** – LDH 1000 – 800 feet preferred / 500 minimum
- handline 1 rear hook-up - 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  or 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  - 300 foot preferred
- **Pump size** – 1250 minimum
- **Ground ladder storage** – 6 preferred / 5 minimum
- **Seating** - 6 preferred / 5 minimum
- **Tank size** – 500 gal minimum
- **Engine** – 400 HP minimum
- **Scene lighting** – yes
- **Color** – solid red to match existing
- **Additional equipment** – none needed
