The Chief's Reports for June and July were reviewed and discussed. Chief advised that the I-91 calls have decreased. Motion by Maureen Brennan and second by William Moran to approve the report as presented. Motion passes by unanimous voice vote.

Paul Muenier advised that he had attended the August 25, 2025 training involving Smyth school bus and said it was excellent. The District collaborated with other departments on this as well.

President Grady attended the recent Cadet graduation and said it was great to see the acknowledgement and for it to be shared with family and others. He also welcomed people back.

President Grady shared information on investing available funds in a Treasury or CD in order to earn interest. Motion by Vice President Patrick Droney to accept the \$2,500 offer for the Driver Stimulator Trailer due to high cost to repair and age with a second by Maureen Brennan. Motion passes by unanimous voice vote.

There is a discussion on the status of the Maintenance vehicle. Motion by Paul Muenier and second by Paul Benis to sell the 2006 Maintenance Vehicle. Motion passes by unanimous voice vote.

## **Committee Reports:**

Apparatus: Deputy Chief Higgins presented the proposed new Engine 14. Several advanced safety features were reviewed. The price w/specs noted, is approximately \$1.2 million dollars.

Motion to add an agenda item to set a district meeting date to vote on the apparatus by Paul Meunier and second by William Moran. Motion passes by unanimous voice vote.
